The BUILDINGS, FOOD SERVICE, AND TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE met at 5:00 P.M. on Monday, October 10, 2016, in the Board Room of the School Board Office, with the following members present: Mr. L. P. Bordelon, III, chairman, Mr. Roger Dale DeHart, vice chairman, and Mr. Gregory Harding. Also in attendance were Mr. Donald Duplantis, Mr. Richard Jackson, Superintendent Philip Martin, and members of the staff.

Chairman Bordelon called the meeting to order. The meeting began with the invocation and Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Mr. Clark Capone, Engineer Intern, All South Consulting Engineers, addressed the Committee regarding the demolition update of Southdown Elementary School (attached).

RECOMMENDATION NO. 1

The Committee recommends that the Board ratify a change order to increase the contract time by thirty-seven (37) days due to weather, changing the contract completion date from September 2, 2016, to October 10, 2016, as provided for in the contract, for the demolition of Southdown Elementary School, and further, authorize the Board president to sign all necessary documents pertaining thereto.
