

## INSTRUCTIONAL SERVICES

### LIBRARIES

1. All schools housing students of seventh (7<sup>th</sup>) grade classification or higher (7-12), on a permanent basis, regardless of number of students enrolled, will be provided with centralized library facilities.
2. All schools with a pupil enrollment of five hundred (500) students or more, regardless of grade levels accommodated, will be provided with centralized library facilities.
3. Schools meeting neither of the above criterion are to be served by classroom collections of library books.
4. Once a school qualifies for and has centralized library services established, these services will continue to be provided even if the grade level or student enrollment should be altered; and, further, that the services of a professional librarian continue to be provided, either on a part-time or a full-time basis, at the discretion of the Superintendent.
5. Contingent upon funding, all schools will be provided with centralized library facilities.
