PROCEEDINGS OF THE TERREBONNE PARISH SCHOOL BOARD

June 21, 2011

The Terrebonne Parish School Board met today at 7:00 P.M. in regular session at its regular meeting place, the Terrebonne Parish School Board Office, 201 Stadium Drive, Houma, Louisiana, with Mr. L. P. Bordelon, III, President, presiding, and the following members present: Mr. Roosevelt Thomas, Vice-President; Mr. Gregory Harding, Mr. Richard Jackson, Ms. Debi Benoit, Ms. Brenda Leroux Babin, Mr. Roger Dale DeHart, Mr. Donald Duplantis, and Mr. Hayes J. Badeaux.

ABSENT: None

Mr. Duplantis led the Board and audience in the invocation and Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Motion of Mr. Duplantis, seconded by Mr. DeHart, unanimously carried, the Board approved the minutes of School Board Meeting of June 7, 2011, as recorded.

The following report of the Education and Policy Committee meeting was presented to the Board with Mr. Jackson, Chairman, presiding:

Dear Members of the Board:

The EDUCATION and POLICY COMMITTEE met in the Board Room of the School Board Office, 201 Stadium Drive, at 5:00 P.M., on Monday, June 6, 2011, with the following members present: Mr. Richard Jackson, Chairman, Ms. Brenda Leroux Babin, Vice-Chairman, and Mr. Donald Duplantis. Also in attendance were Mr. L. P. Bordelon, III, Superintendent Philip Martin, and members of the staff.

Mr. Jackson called the meeting to order. The meeting began with the invocation and Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Ms. Babin presented information highlighting the 'sweet' accomplishments of the culinary students in the introductory food service class at the Career and Technical High School (see attached). She said the class has prepared treats for many school-related functions and events, such as Terrebonne Foundation for Academic Excellence's 5K Run for Excellence and Cajun Food Fest. She stated the class is to be commended for their selfless contributions to our school system and community. Ms. Babin acknowledged Mr. Nason Authement, Supervisor of Secondary Education, and commended him for being "instrumental" in getting the information published.

Ms. Babin discussed a revision to policy FILE: B-11.1 Regular Meetings. She said the change would add an option to have notices of meetings mailed and/or emailed to all Board Members.

FILE: B-11.1

REGULAR MEETINGS

The Terrebonne Parish School Board shall meet in regular session on the first and third Tuesday of each calendar month at 7:00 p.m.

1. Place of Meeting

All meetings of the Terrebonne Parish School Board shall be held at its office on Stadium Drive, Houma, Louisiana, unless a different place shall be designated by resolution or in the notice of the meeting.

2. Notice of Regular Meetings

A notice of regular meetings shall be mailed <u>and/or emailed</u> to all Board Members at least five (5) days in advance of the meeting.

3. Time Limit

The time of regular meetings of the Terrebonne Parish School Board shall be limited to approximately three (3) hours or to such time as proper transaction of business requires. Items requiring extended study shall be taken up at special meetings.

Ref: La. Rev. Stat. Ann. §§17:81, 42:4.1, <u>42.12</u> et seq.; Board minutes, 10-03 89.

Ms. Babin presented a revision to policy FILE: B-12.1 Notice of Meetings. She said the revision would add the wording for posting of notices to the district website, of which is already occurring; however, the policy would then be updated.

FILE: B-12.1

NOTICE OF MEETINGS

The School Board, as all public bodies, shall be required to give written public notice of its regular meetings at the beginning of each calendar year. The notice shall include the dates, times and places of such meetings. Any regular, special, or rescheduled meeting that the School Board may hold, shall require notice no later than twenty-four (24) hours before the meeting. In cases of extraordinary emergencies, however, such notice shall not be required, but the School Board shall give such notice of the meeting as it deems appropriate and circumstances permit.

The written public notice required by the state shall include, but not be limited to posting a copy of the notice at the principal office of the School Board, **posting a copy of the notice on the Terrebonne Parish School Board's Website, and/**or by publicizing the notice in the official journal of the Board no less than twenty-four (24) hours before the meeting. Notice shall also include mailing a copy of the notice to any member of the news media who requests notice of such meetings. Members of the news media shall be given notice of all meetings in the same manner as is given to the members of the Board. Ref: La. Rev. Stat. Ann. §§17:81, 42:4, 42:7, 42:8, 42:19, 42:20, 42:21.

Superintendent Martin summarized the Spring iLEAP/LEAP scores, by grade level (see attached). He said the results are not the "official" School Performance Scores or District Performance Scores, which are released in October; however, this data is where the state scores are derived from.

Mrs. Carol Davis, Assistant Superintendent, presented information regarding a donation by BP to establish Reasoning Minds Math Computer-Based Program in two (2) Terrebonne Parish Schools (see attached). Ms. Tandra LeMay, Government and Program Specialist for BP, was in attendance at the meeting.

Ms. Leslie Boudelier, Math Teacher at Houma Jr. High and State Beta Club Sponsor, presented information on schools participating in the National Beta Club (see attached). She discussed the qualifications for a student to be in Beta and listed the many activities and accomplishments of Terrebonne Parish Beta Club students. Joshua Poche', Houma Jr. High student and State Beta Club President, gave an overview of district, state, and national level competitions for Beta Club members.

Mr. Arthur Joffrion, Supervisor of Federal Programs, and Mrs. Shirley Salter, Supervisor of Special Education, briefly discussed the NCLB and IDEA Consolidated Application for the 2011-2012 school year (see attached). Mr. Bordelon requested the results, once obtained, be reported back to Committee.

RECOMMENDATION NO. 3

The Committee recommends that the Board approve, as presented, the NCLB/IDEA Consolidated Application for Federal Funds for the 2011-2012 school year, in the amount of \$12,080,855.00.
