A moment of silence was observed in memory of Mrs. Judith Henry, retired school secretary and wife of Mr. Harris Henry, Executive Director of Finance and Auxiliary Services, who recently passed away.

Motion of Mr. Duplantis, seconded by Mr. Thomas, unanimously carried, the Board approved the minutes of School Board Meeting of November 13, 2012, as recorded.

The Executive Committee report was presented to the Board.

Motion of Mr. Badeaux, seconded by Mr. Harding, unanimously carried, the Board received the following Executive Committee report in its entirety:

Motion of Dr. Babin, seconded by Mr. DeHart, unanimously carried, the Board reconvened in regular session with all members present, with the exception of Mr. Jackson who was absent **(7:35 P.M.)**. Ms. Benoit entered the meeting during executive session and was present for the remainder of the proceedings.

Motion of Mr. DeHart, seconded by Dr. Babin, unanimously carried, the Board denied the parent appeal for readmission of Student #130162.

Motion of Dr. Babin, seconded by Ms. Benoit, unanimously carried, the Board voted to go into executive session, at this time **(7:40 P.M.)**, relative to a parent appeal for readmission of Student #134640.

Motion of Mr. DeHart, seconded by Dr. Babin, unanimously carried, the Board reconvened in regular session with all members present, with the exception of Mr. Jackson who was absent (8:00 P.M.).

Motion of Mr. Duplantis, seconded by Mr. DeHart, with the exception of Ms. Benoit who objected, the Board allowed Student #134640 to return to the base school in January 2013, subject to signing a contract.

Motion of Mr. DeHart, seconded by Mr. Thomas, unanimously carried, the Board voted to go into executive session, at this time **(8:05 P.M.)**, relative to "Matter Pertaining to Pending Litigation – Joel Williams versus Docket No. 161506, Terrebonne Parish School Board, 32<sup>nd</sup> Judicial District Court, Parish of Terrebonne, State of Louisiana."

Motion of Mr. DeHart, seconded by Mr. Badeaux, unanimously carried, the Board reconvened in regular session with all members present, with the exception of Mr. Jackson who was absent (8:20 P.M.).

Motion of Mr. Thomas, seconded by Mr. Duplantis, unanimously carried, the Board authorized Mr. Bernard Levy, Attorney, to execute a settlement relative to "Pending Litigation – Joel Williams versus Docket No. 161506, Terrebonne Parish School Board, 32<sup>nd</sup> Judicial District Court, Parish of Terrebonne, State of Louisiana."

Motion of Mr. Badeaux, seconded by Mr. Harding, unanimously carried, the Board rescheduled the School Board Meeting of January 1, 2013, to January 8, 2013 (Due to Christmas Holidays), and rescheduled the agenda deadline from noon Wednesday, December 26, 2012, to 4:30 P.M. Wednesday, December 19, 2012.

At this time, Mr. Thomas addressed the Board regarding the 1965 Consent Decree and the recent ruling by Judge Timothy Kelley that the diversion of public tax dollars dedicated for public education to private entities (voucher program) is unconstitutional based on the provisions of the Louisiana Constitution.

Mr. Clayton Lovell, Board Attorney, addressed the Board regarding the foregoing matter.

A lengthy discussion ensued.

Mr. Thomas requested that School Board Members be kept informed of any future developments as it relates to the voucher program.

President Bordelon reminded School Board Members of the upcoming "Teenager of the Year" Recognition Award Ceremony which will be held on Saturday, January 12, 2013, at 6:00 P.M. at the American Legion Home on Legion Avenue.

Motion of Mr. Duplantis, seconded by Mr. DeHart, unanimously carried, the Board voted to adjourn its meeting **(8:45 P.M.)**.
