## PROCEEDINGS OF THE TERREBONNE PARISH SCHOOL BOARD

## January 8, 2013

The Terrebonne Parish School Board met today at 7:00 P.M. in regular session at its regular meeting place, the Terrebonne Parish School Board Office, 201 Stadium Drive, Houma, Louisiana, with Mr. L. P. Bordelon, III, President, presiding, and the following members present: Mr. Roger Dale DeHart, Vice-President; Mr. Roosevelt Thomas, Mr. Richard Jackson, Ms. Debi Benoit, Dr. Brenda Leroux Babin, Mr. Donald Duplantis, and Mr. Hayes J. Badeaux.

ABSENT: Mr. Gregory Harding

Ms. Benoit led the Board and audience in the invocation and Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

A moment of silence was observed in memory of Elaine Jackson, retired school paraprofessional; Ernestine Perkins, retired custodian; Joyce Babin, retired school food service employee, and Robert McGuire, custodian at Dularge Elementary School, who recently passed away.

Motion of Mr. Duplantis, seconded by Mr. Badeaux, unanimously carried, the Board approved the minutes of School Board Meeting of December 4, 2012, as recorded.

At this time, President Bordelon thanked fellow School Board Members, Ramona Brunet, Wanda Lovern, Debbie Cope, Melissa Hagen, and Jan Blanchard for all the assistance and cooperation he received in the past two years, as School Board President.

President Bordelon announced that the first order of business was the election of the President and Vice-President of the Terrebonne Parish School Board for a one-year term beginning this date.

Mr. Duplantis placed in nomination for the presidency the name of Mr. Roger Dale DeHart.

Ms. Benoit placed in nomination for the presidency the name of Dr. Brenda Leroux Babin.

Motion of Mr. Thomas, seconded by Mr. Duplantis, unanimously carried, the nominations for the office of President were closed.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, That said Superintendent, Executive Director of Finance, and Supervisor of Finance be and are authorized to release any safekeeping receipt and/or security pledged to the Terrebonne Parish School Board provided that each release will bear the signatures of at least two of the above authorized individuals.

Motion of Mr. Thomas, seconded by Mr. Bordelon, unanimously carried, the Board approved a family and medical leave in accordance with Policy (FILE: F-11.4a) for April Adams, Teacher at Broadmoor Elementary School, beginning April 26, 2013, through May 23, 2013 (medical).

Motion of Dr. Babin, seconded by Mr. Badeaux, unanimously carried, the Board voted to go into executive session, at this time (7:25 P.M.), relative to a parent appeal for early readmission of Student #109071.

Motion of Mr. Bordelon, seconded by Dr. Babin, unanimously carried, the Board reconvened in regular session with all members present, with the exception of Mr. Thomas who was absent (7:35 P.M.).

Motion of Mr. Duplantis, seconded by Mr. Badeaux, with the exception of Dr. Babin and Ms. Benoit who objected, the Board allowed Student #109071 to return to Terrebonne High School immediately, subject to signing a contract.

Motion of Mr. Duplantis, seconded by Mr. Jackson, unanimously carried, the Board voted to adjourn its meeting **(8:00 P.M.)**.
