Dear Members of the Board:

The Buildings, Food Service, and Transportation Committee met at 5:00 P.M. on Monday, January 12, 2015, in the Board Room of the School Board Office with the following members present: Mr. Gregory Harding, Chairman, Mr. Richard Jackson, Vice-Chairman, and Mr. Roger Dale DeHart. Also in attendance were Mr. Roosevelt Thomas, Board President, Mr. L. P. Bordelon, III, Mr. Donald Duplantis, Superintendent Philip Martin, and members of the staff.

Mr. Harding called the meeting to order. The meeting began with the invocation and Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Mr. Bordelon addressed the Committee regarding property located adjacent to Mulberry Elementary School.

RECOMMENDATION NO. 1

The Committee recommends that the Board allow the Superintendent and Staff to enter into negotiations for the possible purchase of a tract of land adjacent to Mulberry Elementary School.

Superintendent Martin addressed the Committee regarding a District Infrastructure, Demographic, and Facility Analysis.

RECOMMENDATION NO. 2

The Committee recommends that the Board allow the Superintendent to conduct a District-Wide Infrastructure, Demographic, and Facility Analysis projecting short-term and long-term needs, and establish a budget of \$75,000.00, funds to be derived from the General Operating Fund.

Mr. Ronald Boudreaux, P. E., Ronald J. Boudreaux, Inc., addressed the Committee regarding the substantial completion of the Main Electrical Panel Replacement Project at Oaklawn Jr. High School (see attached).

RECOMMENDATION NO. 3

The Committee recommends that the Board approve the substantial completion, dated January 7, 2015, for the Main Electrical Panel Replacement Project at Oaklawn Jr. High School, subject to the punch list; upon completion of the punch list, final inspection, and receipt of the lien-free certificate, authorize the release of retainage, and further, authorize the Board President to sign all necessary documents pertaining thereto.

Mr. Craig C. Hebert, AIA, A Professional Architect Corp., addressed the Committee regarding an update of the Press Box Renovation Project at South Terrebonne High School (see attached).

RECOMMENDATION NO. 4

The Committee recommends that the Board ratify a change order for an extension of the contract of ten (10) days (from February 25, 2015, to March 7, 2015), and increase the project cost by \$7,136.00 (from \$244,000.00 to \$251,136.00) due to unforeseen damages discovered during demolition, monies to be derived from contingency funds in the South Terrebonne High School Press Box Renovation Project, and further, authorize the Board President to sign all necessary documents pertaining thereto.

Mr. Donald Chamberlain, Plant Operations Manager, addressed the Committee regarding maintenance updates.

There being no further business to come before the **Buildings**, **Food Service**, **and Transportation Committee**, the meeting was adjourned at 5:55 P.M.
