Dear Members of the Board:

The FINANCE, INSURANCE, and SECTION 16 LANDS COMMITTEE met at 5:00 P.M. on Monday, June 18, 2018, in the Board Room of the School Board Office with the following members present: Mr. Donald Duplantis, chairman, and Mr. Roosevelt Thomas, vice chairman. Mrs. Debi Benoit was absent. Also in attendance were Mr. Roger Dale DeHart, Board president, Mr. L. P. Bordelon, III, Mr. Richard Jackson, Superintendent Philip Martin, and members of the staff.

Chairman Duplantis called the meeting to order. The meeting began with the invocation and Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Mrs. Benoit entered the meeting at this time.

Ms. Diane Powell, Administrator, Terrebonne Parish Consolidated Government Head Start Program, addressed the Committee regarding the renewal of an agreement between the Terrebonne Parish Consolidated Government Head Start Program and the Terrebonne Parish School Board (attached).

RECOMMENDATION NO. 1

The Committee recommends that the Board renew the agreement, as presented, between the Terrebonne Parish Consolidated Government Head Start Program and Terrebonne Parish School Board, under the current terms and conditions, for preparation of meals at Legion Park Elementary, Lisa Park Elementary, Gibson Elementary, and Schriever Elementary Schools beginning August 7, 2018, and ending May 23, 2019, and further, authorize the Board president to sign all necessary documents pertaining thereto.
