PROCEEDINGS OF THE TERREBONNE PARISH SCHOOL BOARD

January 9, 2018

The Terrebonne Parish School Board met today at 6:00 P.M. in regular session at its regular meeting place, the Terrebonne Parish School Board Office, 201 Stadium Drive, Houma, Louisiana, with Mr. Roger Dale DeHart, president, presiding, and the following members present: Ms. Vicki Bonvillain, vice president; Mr. Roosevelt Thomas, Mr. Gregory Harding, Mr. Richard Jackson, Mrs. Debi Benoit, Mr. L. P. Bordelon, III, and Mr. Donald Duplantis.

ABSENT: Dr. Brenda Leroux Babin

Mr. Jackson led the Board and audience in the invocation and Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

A moment of silence was observed in memory of Tommy Thompson, former Terrebonne Parish School Board Member, supervisor, and principal; Kathy Tamplain, retired central office supervisor; Jeanette T. Boudreaux, retired teacher aide; Amelia L. Breaux, retired school food service employee; Barbara L. Malbrough, retired school teacher; Eugene J. Aycock, retired custodian; Rose Dell Franklin, retired custodian, and Marguerite C. Pellegrin, retired school food service employee, who recently passed away.
