Resolved, that the Terrebonne Parish School Board does hereby proclaim the week of October 21-25, 2019, as "National School Bus Safety Week;" and be it further

(2) Resolution in Observance of the Month of October 2019 as National Anti-Bullying Month

<u>RECOMMENDATION</u>: That the Board approve the following resolution in observance of the month of October 2019 as National Anti-Bullying Month:

RESOLUTION

Whereas school bullying has become an increasingly significant problem in the United States;

Whereas almost twenty percent (20%) of the youth in the United States are estimated to be involved in bullying each year, either as a bully or as a victim;

Whereas an estimated one hundred sixty thousand students in kindergarten through twelfth grade miss school every day to a fear of being bullied;

Whereas bullying can take many forms, including verbal, physical, and most recently in cyberspace, and can happen in many places on and off school grounds;

Whereas it is important for Terrebonne Parish School District administrators to be aware of bullying, and to encourage discussion of the problem as a school system; and

Whereas the Terrebonne Parish School District is united in its desire to educate and encourage positive behaviors and to eliminate bullying behaviors; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, that the Terrebonne Parish School District hereby proclaims its unified commitment to the education and prevention of bullying within our communities and schools, exploring solutions to the problem, including cyber-bullying, and offering support in raising awareness and recognizing the month of October 2019 as National Anti-Bullying Month in Terrebonne Parish Public Schools; and be it further

Resolved, that copies of this resolution be forwarded to all Terrebonne Parish public schools and office buildings.

RECOMMENDATION NO. 1

Mrs. Becky Breaux, Chief Financial Officer, presented information on the Request for Proposals (RFPs) for district internet services.

RECOMMENDATION NO. 2

Mr. Aubrey "Bubba" Orgeron, Assistant Superintendent, presented information regarding Outstanding School Systems and Schools with Top Growth, according to results from the Louisiang Department of Education. He stated that Terrebonne Parish School District ranked seventh (7th) in the State as an Outstanding School System and had Top Growth in the following areas: African-American Students, Economically Disadvantaged Students, and Students with Disabilities. For 2018-2019, within Southeast Louisiana, Terrebonne Parish had nine (9) Outstanding Legion Park Elementary, Upper Little Caillou Elementary, Schools: Terrebonne High, Schriever Elementary, Dularge Elementary, Acadian Elementary, Gibson Elementary, Caldwell Middle, and Elysian Fields Middle. Mr. Oregon also presented student Progress Index data for each elementary, middle, and junior high school, based on the results from the Louisiana Department of Education. Nineteen (19) of our schools have a student progress index of 90% or above (attached).
