INSTRUCTIONAL SERVICES

LIBRARIES

- 1. All schools housing students of seventh (7th) grade classification or higher (7-12), on a permanent basis, regardless of number of students enrolled, will be provided with centralized library facilities.
- 2. All schools with a pupil enrollment of five hundred (500) students or more, regardless of grade levels accommodated, will be provided with centralized library facilities.
- 3. Schools meeting neither of the above criterion are to be served by classroom collections of library books.
- 4. Once a school qualifies for and has centralized library services established, these services will continue to be provided even if the grade level or student enrollment should be altered; and, further, that the services of a professional librarian continue to be provided, either on a part-time or a full-time basis, at the discretion of the Superintendent.
- 5. Contingent upon funding, all schools will be provided with centralized library facilities.
