

## RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

### PRIVACY OF STUDENT BODY IDENTIFICATION

In attempting to uphold all federal, state, and local laws, all attempts will be made to protect the identity or possible identity of students who may be involved by the nature of their presence on the school grounds. The intent of this policy is to protect the privacy of the student body and to control, at authority's discretion, situations which would tend to impede the investigative process or illegally identify students to any other agency or person other than authorized. The basis for this policy is contained in the following Louisiana Revised Statutes 14:328, Part 14: 328C and Part 14:329.5C:

**OBSTRUCTION OR INTERFERENCE WITH MEMBERS OF STAFF, FACULTY,  
OR STUDENTS OF EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS: TRESPASS, DAMAGE  
TO PROPERTY; FELONY; PENALTIES**

#### R.S. 14:328C

No person shall willfully refuse or fail to leave the property of, or any building or other facility owned, operated, controlled or administered by the governing authority of any such institution of higher education, upon being requested to do so by the chief administrative officer or his/her designee charged with maintaining order on the campus or grounds and in the facilities thereon, if such person is committing, threatens to commit, or incites others to commit, any act which would disrupt, impair, interfere with or obstruct the lawful missions, processes, procedures or functions of the educational institution.

#### R.S. 14:329.5C

No person shall willfully refuse or fail to leave the property of, or any building or other facility owned, operated or controlled by the state or any agency or political subdivision thereof, upon being requested to do so by the chief administrative officer thereof, or by his/her designee charged with maintaining order on the campus or grounds and in its facilities, or a dean of such institution of learning, if such person is committing, threatens to commit, or incites others to commit, any act which would or is likely to disrupt, impair, interfere with or obstruct the lawful missions, processes, procedures or functions of such institutions of learning.
