Lowe's Toolbox for Education Grants

Through our support for public education, we're closing the funding gap facing many schools today. Each year, the Lowe's Toolbox for Education grants program contributes more than \$5 million to fund improvements at public schools in the United States.

Projects should fall into one of the following categories: technology upgrades, tools for STEM programs, facility renovations and safety improvements. Grant requests can range from \$2,000 to \$100,000. A large majority of grants will be given in the \$2,000 to \$5,000 range.

The fall application cycle will run August 3 – October 16, 2015. The application link will be posted on August 3.

QSM Grants

The Quality Science & Mathematics Grant Program(QSM) was established for the purpose of awarding grants for \$750 to provide materials and equipment to eligible MATHEMATICS and SCIENCE PUBLIC SCHOOL TEACHERS. Grants for approved materials and equipment will be awarded on a competitive basis to individual classroom teachers to use in providing standards-based instruction to help meet state accountability goals. Applicants must show that their proposals will enhance the quality of instruction for regular education students who are enrolled in mathematics or science classes.

Some Tips for Applying for a Grant

Start preparing the application early. Allow plenty of time to gather required information and to submit well before the deadline. Don't let a power failure make your submission be late!

Keep your audience in mind. Make your points understandable. Provide accurate and honest information. Candid accounts of problems and realistic plans to address them can pique the readers' interest. If any required information or data must be omitted, explain why. Make sure the information included in each table, chart, attachment, etc. is consistent with the proposal narrative and information in other tables.
