Important Things for Seniors

If you have applied for a college and have not seen Mrs. Vice for a copy of your ACT scores and transcript, please do so. Mrs. Vice will mail your transcript and ACT scores to the colleges of your choice. If she is not in your office, please leave her a note stating your name, which colleges you need your information sent to, and what you need sent.

Attention: Parents

Parents are eligible for an annual \$10,000 scholarship for their child when they register at www.parentanswerservice.com.

If you have financial aid questions or questions about filling out your FAFSA, call 1-800-259-5626 ext. 1012. This is the number for LOSFA (Louisiana Office of Student Financial Assistance). They are available Monday through Friday from 8:00am to 4:30pm.

You may begin filling out your FAFSA information as soon as you receive your income tax information. By filling out this form you will be automatically registered for TOPS. www.fafsa.ed.gov Now this is where you will file your federal financial aid form. This is the site that you must visit at least twice during high school. Once to receive a pin number for you and your parents and then again once your parents have filed their income tax returns. Don't overlook this website and don't think that it's not for you if you're a well-off student. It's for everyone and everyone needs to apply. The priority deadline for the FAFSA is April 1st for TOPS.
