

PROCEEDINGS OF THE TERREBONNE PARISH SCHOOL BOARD

MAY 11, 2004

The Terrebonne Parish School Board met today at 7:00 P.M. in **special session** at its regular meeting place, the Terrebonne Parish School Board Office, 201 Stadium Drive, Houma, Louisiana, with Mr. Clark J. Bonvillain, President, presiding, and the following members present: Mr. L. P.
