Each and every student at Schriever Elementary will strive for success in academics and behavior.

With so many different people and so many different opinions and ideas, disagreements (or conflicts) sometimes happen. When they do, it's important for children to know how to resolve the problems and move on. Ask your child the following questions; "What happens when you feel angry? What can you do to calm down? Have you ever had an argument with a friend? How did you make up?" Remind your child that they should not lose control if they get angry. Taking it out on others never solves anything. Instead, they should admit to themselves that they are angry and try to figure out why. Explain to your child that it helps to talk about their anger with an adult, such as a parent, a teacher or a relative. Once a child talks about the anger, those bad feelings usually start to go away. Never getting angry is impossible. So, tell your child that how they act when they are angry can make any situation better or worse. They should not let anger be the boss, instead they need to take charge of it!
