All students in K-3 will achieve on level status in math skills as measured with the Math Screener (IXL) by the end of the school year. Each student has set a personal goal for the year. Please ask your child about their goals and how they are progressing towards the goals. Schriever Elementary strives to engage our families in learning with monthly activities such as our Falling for Good Character, Patriotic Picnic, and Turkey in Disguise project. The math assessment may include problems that require students to use multiple operations in one problem.

### Example:

Jean was unboxing some old winter clothes. She found four boxes of clothing. Inside each box there were three scarves and six mittens. How many pieces of clothing does Jean have total?

Solution:  $4 \times (3 + 6) = ?$ 

 $4 \times 9 = 36$ 

Jean has 36 pieces of clothing in all.
