2018-2019 KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION PROCEDURES

Kindergarten registration will occur on February 21, 2018, and February 22, 2018, at each public school in the parents' domicile area, and will continue at each school until May 4, 2018. After May 4th, registration will continue throughout the summer at the Terrebonne Parish School Board Office. **Children must attend the school in the district where their parents or legal guardians live. For registrations**, parents should bring **proof of residency**, **immunization record**, **birth certificate**, **and social security card**. If your child is currently registered and attending Terrebonne Parish School District's Pre-K Program, they DO NOT have to be re-registered. These students will automatically be enrolled.

SPRING 2018 STATE TESTING

The Louisiana Department of Education has made a few adjustments to our state testing program this year. Students in grades 5 - 8 will be taking English Language Arts, Math, and Social Studies via the online method. The online testing window for grades 5 - 8 online will extend from April 9 - May 4, 2018. The District has been given general testing guidelines; however, each school will create a school/grade specific testing schedule. Students in grades 3 and 4 will take English Language Arts, Math, and Social Studies (paper based) during the week of April 30 - May 4, 2018. All students in grades 3 - 8 will take the Science Field Assessment within their testing windows.

The assessment window for students enrolled in End-of-Course classes will be from April 23 – May 18, 2018. Juniors and any interested Seniors will be scheduled to take the ACT on March 20, 2018, with make-ups scheduled on April 24, 2018. The ACT may also be given online from March 20 – 29, 2018.
