The Committee recommends that the Board accept the lowest bids received, meeting all specifications, on Meat and Frozen Foods for the 2015-2016 spring session from F. Christiana & Co., Inc., Marrero, LA, in the amount of \$194,480.84; Diamond Foods Distributors, Inc., Jefferson, LA, in the amount of \$332,027.74; and Lacassagne's, Inc., Baton Rouge, LA, in the amount of \$65,736.50, funds to be derived from the Child Nutrition Program Fund.
