3. Matter bearing upon option to extend the service agreement providing kitchen hood inspections (Proposed Recommendation)

The Committee recommends that the Board approve the option to extend the service agreement providing kitchen hood inspections with Fire & Safety Technicians, Inc., Houma, LA, from July 1, 2017, to June 30, 2018, with no price increase, funds to be derived from the Child Nutrition Fund.

The Committee recommends that the Board approve the option to extend the current contract on Automated Fuels and Dispensing Services with Fleetcor, Charlotte, North Carolina, for an additional three (3) year period, from July 1, 2017, to June 30, 2020, under the same terms and conditions.

The Committee recommends that the Board approve the option to extend the current service agreement providing HVAC filter supplies and delivery services with Acadiana Filter Service, New Iberia, LA, for a five (5) year period from July 1, 2017, to June 30, 2022, under the same terms and conditions.
