3. Matter bearing upon Bus Lease Agreement between South Louisiana Wetlands Discovery Center and Terrebonne Parish School Board (Proposed Recommendation) - Jack Moore, Risk Manager

The Committee recommends that the Board enter into a Bus Lease Agreement between South Louisiana Wetlands Discovery Center and Terrebonne Parish School Board, effective June 3, 2019, to June 22, 2019, provided buses shall run during normal operating hours on weekdays, as needed, mileage reimbursement at a rate of \$1.75 per mile driven, provide and pay bus drivers approved by Terrebonne Parish School Board, provided all necessary insurance requirements are

met, and further, authorize the Board president to sign all necessary documents pertaining thereto.
