The Committee recommends that the Board accept the renewal offer for Excess Casualty Insurance renewal from Berkley Insurance Company (Arthur J. Gallagher of Louisiana, Inc., Broker of Record) covering Automobile Liability, General Liability, Errors and Omissions Liability, and Nurse's Professional Liability with limits of \$1,000,000.00 per occurrence with a \$3,000,000.00 General Aggregate limit for General Liability, \$1,000,000.00 per accident for Auto Liability, and \$1,000,000.00 per claim for Errors and Omissions and Nurse's Professional

Liability, subject to \$300,000.00 Self-Insured Retention with an annual premium of \$169,050.00, rejecting Uninsured/Underinsured Motorist Liability, effective July 1, 2019, through July 1, 2020, and further, authorize the Board president to sign all necessary documents pertaining thereto.
