College & Career Coaching (Grade 12)

Trained college and career coaches will provide one-on-one support to every high school senior, helping them with regionally-relevant workforce and post-secondary information. This will include career exploration, FAFSA completion, test scheduling, and college application preparation. The coaches complement our TPSD counselors and help students move from uncertainty to confident action.

College & Career Awareness Modules (Grades 8-11)

Trained college and career coaches will visit all grades 8-11 students in groups as part of the College & Career Awareness program. A series of videos will be used to help students overcome obstacles and pursue post-secondary education, as well as the use of interest surveys.

Graduation Plan Assistance (Grades 8-11)

Career Compass will assist schools streamline the annual review process of student Individual Graduation Plans (IGPs) in accordance with Bulletin 741. This service includes collaboration meetings with a trained staff member, digital activities for students and data reporting dashboards for schools.
