#### TRANSPORTATION CAR RIDERS

#### WALKERS/BIKE RIDERS

Parents of walkers and bike riders are asked to send their children after the 8:15 bell has sounded. Students who are riding bikes and walking around on the corner and in the streets prior to the bell are not supervised and pose an unsafe situation for themselves and others.

Parents of walkers and bike riders are asked to make alternate arrangements with their children for rainy days (ride bus or get in car line). If they know in advance, they will know what to do at that time.
