Meet the Principal:

We are starting this year off right by teaching the students how they should maintain their behavior in the classroom, in the cafeteria, in the hallways, on the playground, in the bathroom, in the library, and in the computer lab. This year your child will be able to earn monthly rewards through out PBIS system. Every 4 1/2 weeks your child may be eligible to attend an event. The students will have an opportunity to earn signatures on a daily basis by achieving A's in conduct. Don't worry, we know our children aren't perfect, so they will only have to use 50% of the possible signatures to attend an event, and they cannot have an office or bus referral for the PBIS marking period. The first PBIS marking period ends on September 5th. We want our students to continue with positive behavior as many days as possible, which means the students will be able to focus in class and get more work completed during the school day. This system will reinforce some life skills like saving for things that they want to earn. Many students will have more than enough signatures to attend, so students may purchase items from the PAW Mart. A list of the items and upcoming events were sent home in test folders the second week of school. The next PBIS events will take place September 13th - 15th, so be on the lookout for letters explaining the event.

Progress reports will be available in the Student Progress Center on Thursday, September 7th. Don't forget to join us for our Texas Roadhouse Dine to Donate on September 7th starting at 3pm.
